“Making thinking visible: The roles of equitable talk and scientific modeling in the classroom”



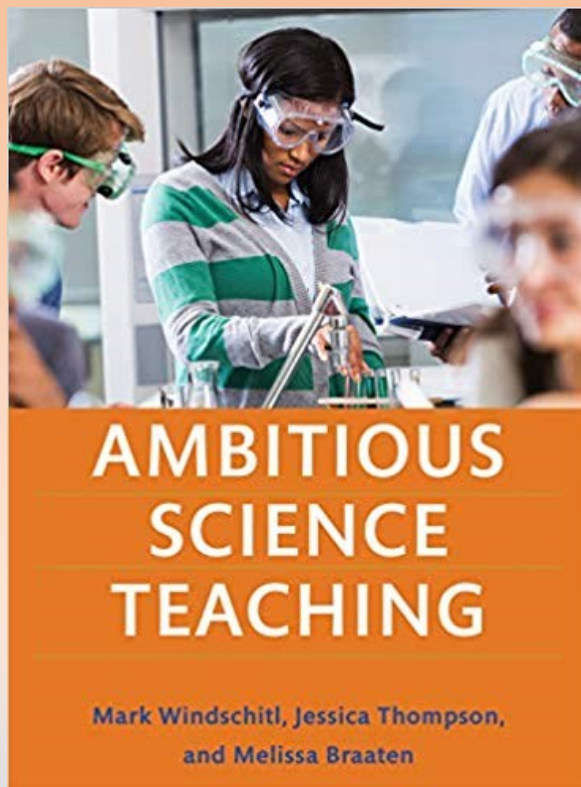
Mark Windschitl is a professor of Science Teaching and Learning at the University of Washington.
